*How to reach the EHPA offices located in the Renewable Energy House, Rue d'Arlon 63-67, 1040 Brussels*

**Arriving by train at Brussels Central:** If you get off at Central station, follow the white and blue M signs for the metro. Walk through a long underground tunnel in order to reach the metro station. Once you enter, take the metro 1 direction Stockel/Stokkel or 5 in the direction of Hermann-Debroux/Delta. You can take all trains! Get off at **Maalbeek/Maelbeek**, take the exit Rue de la Loi, turn left and then take the second street to your left – you are on Rue d'Arlon (5 min walk).

**Arriving by train at Brussels South station (Bruxelles Midi - Brussel Zuid) to the office:** International trains such as the ICE, Thalys and Eurostar stop at Brussels South station. Take metro line 2 or 6 direction Simonis-Elisabeth. Get off either at **Arts-Loi/Kunst-Wet** station and walk down the Rue de la Loi until you reach Rue d'Arlon on your right (10 min maximum) or change at Arts-Loi/Kunst-Wet station and get off at **Maalbeek/Maelbeek** (see above).

#### **Arriving by car:**

No matter from which motorway you are entering Brussels, follow the main indication '**Institutions Européennes/Europese Instellingen**'. Rue d'Arlon is located between the two main streets of the European Quarters: Rue de la Loi and Rue Belliard.

**From Brussels National Airport:** The quickest route is via the airport express bus (number 12). During daytime, the bus leaves every 10 minutes. One-Way tickets cost about 4 EUR. Get off at the terminus, Place Luxembourg, which is a square dominated by the European Parliament building on one side. Take rue d'Arlon, on the opposite side of the Parliament. Walk down Rue d'Arlon until you've reached the REH (approx. 5 min walk).

You can also take a train from the airport. One-Way tickets cost about 4 EUR. Get off at **Brussels Central** station (Bruxelles Central - Brussel Centraal), and then proceed as explained above.

A trip by taxi from the airport to the office costs about 30-40 EUR,

depending on traffic.

**From Charleroi Airport (Ryanair flights):** Take the designated bus (navette) to Brussels South Station. Once arrived at Brussels South station, follow the white and blue M signs for the metro and take metro line 2 or 6 direction Simonis (Elisabeth). Get off either at **Arts-Loi/Kunst-Wet** station or at **Maalbeek/Maelbeek** (see above).

A trip by taxi from the airport to the office costs around 100 EUR, depending on traffic.
